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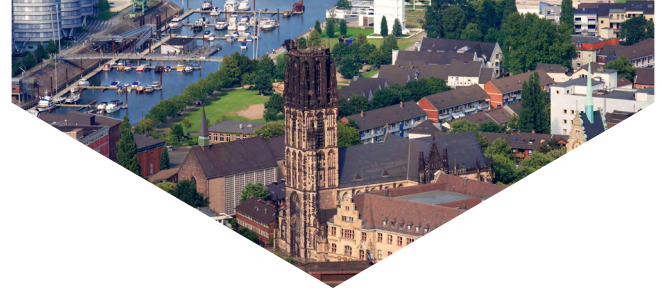
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WELCOME TO DUISBURG!

LANDSCHAFTSPARK DUISBURG-NORD

"HANDS ON" INDUSTRIAL CULTURE

At Landschaftspark Duisburg-Nord, discover the ironworks, a true industrial culture landmark.

Industrial history, leisure and culture all abound on the 200-hectare site. There are numerous attractions to be found here such as a high-wire course, the diving gasometer and a climbing garden in the midst of former ore bunkers. In the evening, lighting designed by the British artist Jonathan Park transforms the ironworks into a fascinating spectacle. Explore this unique landscape on a tour with our guide or a former worker at the steel mill, who can tell you from his own experience how workers used to "slave away" here.

TIGER & TURTLE – MAGIC MOUNTAIN

THE ONLY WALK-ON ROLLER COASTER IN THE WORLD

Discover the only roller coaster in the world where you can take a walking tour and find out what “Tiger and Turtle” is all about. The sculpture towers 20 metres high and can be seen from afar on top of Heinrich Hildebrand Höhe in the south of the city. Its shimmering silver curves beckon visitors from a distance. During the evening tour, you learn fascinating facts about this work of art – from the inception to the artists and its completion before a backdrop of glittering lights.

Architects offices from all over the world like Foster + Partners or Basler & de Meuron have added a special flair to the innovative waterfront location with their buildings. The NRW Archive, Rhineland Department, is also a real eye-catcher.

Learn more about the Master Plan for Duisburg – developed by Lord Norman Foster – on your tour. Its emergence, implementation and future at Duisburg's Inner Harbour and expansion to include centre city is a unique pilot project in NRW – perhaps even in Germany as a whole.

RUHRORT AND WOMEN

STRONG PERSONALITIES IN THREE CENTURIES

Especially in the port district of Ruhrort, strong women held the fate of the district in their hands for many long years. Find out more about three important Ruhrort women who pulled the strings here for three centuries.

Aletta Haniel, a single mother and successful entrepreneur from the 18th century, Amalie Weidner-Steinhaus, a folk poet from the 19th century, and Johanna Niederhellmann, a committed resistance fighter during the Nationalist Socialist era.

In addition, you will learn interesting things about the working world of women in the course of industrialisation, inland shipping life and anecdotes on local history.

AN ATMOSPHERIC BOAT TRIP

An individual boat tour around the remote corners of the world's biggest inland port can be enjoyed in the cult motor yacht OSKAR.

The tour starts at the Schifferbörse pier. With a view of the Rhine, it takes in the Hafenkanal (port canal), the Möweninsel (seagull island) and Schiffsfriedhof (ship graveyard). Later on, the little boat chugs its way to the Ruhrort port basin. Duisburg's first container terminal and the old listed shipyard are also part of the tour.

The old motor yacht OSKAR allows us to explore every aspect of the port.

In 1919, the company Krupp gave its gravel excavation site in Wedau to the city of Duisburg with the instruction to create a sports and recreational area for the local population. This led to the creation of Germany's biggest and most diverse sports and recreation park on an area now covering some 200 hectares. The Regattabahn is world-famous. MSV Duisburg play their opponents in the schauinsland-reisen-Arena. There is an indoor ice rink, athletics facilities, a swimming complex and a high ropes course. Several clubs and associations are based here. The guided tour can be taken on foot or by bike.
